Eligibility

- Members of underrepresented racial/ethnic group as defined by the National Institutes of Health (diversity.nih.gov/about-us/population-underrepresented)
- Completed at least 1 semester of undergraduate coursework
- Have a strong interest in microbiology, immunology, public health, or bioengineering
- Commit 10-15hrs to research per week

Funding

- Stipend covering 10 wks of research during Fall and Spring semesters for 4 semesters
- Support for travel to national scientific conferences
